Safety, Knowledge,
Understanding & Skills

The 4-H Shooting Sports Program is a hands on firearms safety training and natural resources program for girls and boys ages 9 to 19 years old.

- **Certified 4-H volunteer instructors** supervise each 4-H Shooting Sports Program session. Many hold dual certification with other state and nationally recognized education programs.
- **Safety** is always a primary concern. Youth and adults are trained to know and adhere to the Ten Commandments of firearm safety.
- **Knowledge** about firearms and the natural environment is featured as the volunteers share years of experiences.
- **Skills** are developed under the watchful eyes of the instructors. For some youth, these are new. Others improve and practice their techniques.
- **Understanding** is the most important component of the 4-H Shooting Sports project. It is developed as youth and adults become aware of their rights, responsibilities and their role in the natural environment.

- ▶ **\$ 70.00 per participant** - includes: workshop materials, Saturday meals (breakfast, lunch & dinner), Sunday meals (breakfast & lunch) and drinks.
- ▶ **\$ 80.00 per participant** - includes: workshop materials, Saturday meals (breakfast, lunch & dinner), Sunday meals (breakfast & lunch), drinks, and lodging.
- ▶ Each discipline must have 5 participants before it can be offered.

A Regional 4-H Shooting Sports Living History & Muzzleloading Workshop

What: A New York 4-H Shooting Sports Program Instructor Certification Workshop to certify volunteer leaders as 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors in Living History and Muzzleloading. Adults will be certified to teach 4-H Living History and Muzzleloading to youth participating in formal 4-H Shooting Sports Programs and in camp situations. Each state maintains its own standards for certification that may exceed those established by the National 4-H Shooting Sports Committee. Participants will be able to complete requirements in only one discipline. All equipment will be supplied. The workshop adheres to all National 4-H Shooting Sports curriculum standards. A minimum of five participants in each discipline is required to hold the workshop.

When: Saturday Oct. 10 & Sunday, Oct. 11, 2009. Participants from out of town are welcome to arrive the evening of Friday, Oct. 9. Registration is due by Monday, Sept. 28, 2009.

Where: The workshop will be held at El Rancho de Paz, 2857 Montrose Turnpike, Owego, NY 13827.

Who: The workshop is for those currently involved in the 4-H Shooting Sports Project and those interested in becoming instructors. Teen leaders are welcome and will be recognized as Junior Leaders in this project area. We encourage participation, regardless of gender or physical challenges. Our goal is to involve people who are interested in teaching young people how to shoot safely and to help them learn about the natural environment. This workshop will certify that individuals are trained to be an instructor. Your local county is responsible for approving you as a 4-H volunteer.

Training: A minimum of 14 hours training will be done the 4-H way- "**Learning By Doing**".

Lodging, Meals and Cost: Lodging is in a spacious camp bunkhouse with comfortable bunk beds, showers and rest room facilities. There is both a men's and women's sections. Plenty of parking is available.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided on Saturday. Breakfast and lunch are provided on Sunday.

Sutler's Tent: There will be a **Sutler's Area** set up for folks to rent a "Blanket" where folks can bring their "wares" to trade or sell. The cost to reserve a "blanket" is a \$10.00 donation to the 4-H Shooting Sports program. All other costs are supported through the efforts of the NYS 4-H Shooting Sports Committee and supportive donors.
